## **HOW TO BE PREPARED FOR A CLAY FOR KIDS POTTERY CLASS**

- The ideal location for our program is a room with a sink located on the main floor so we can use our dollies for transporting numerous heavy items. When possible we would appreciate using one room for all classes. Possibly the art/ science room.
- 2. Kindly have a table or desk ready near an electrical outlet for the pottery wheel demonstration, with paper towels and at least 250 ml water.
- 3. Each student will need a nametag, individual or shared small containers of water and 2 double-pointed, round toothpicks.
- 4. During a 10-15 minute demonstration, the instructor will talk to the students about clay and make a cup on the pottery wheel.
- Initial instructions are then given for the students to work at their desks on their hand-built projects, additional instructions being given as necessary
- 6. Adult helpers are required for kindergarten, 1 for each 5 children. 1 or 2 adults are always welcomed for grades 1-3. If the class has over 32 students adults will be needed with a ratio of 1 adult to every 5 students.
