## **PROCEDURES for Clay Making an Slip Glazing**

**If your project is curriculum based you will receive a P.P.P. before your class date.**

1. The ideal location for our program is a room with a sink located on the main floor so we can use our dollies for transporting numerous heavy items. When possible we would appreciate using one room for all classes. Possibly the art/ science room.
2. Kindly have tables or desks divided into groups of approximately 6 students each. Please have paper towels and several small containers of water per group.
3. Each student will need a nametag, PAPER TOWELS, individual or shared small containers of water and 2 double-pointed, round toothpicks.
4. During a 10-15 minute demonstration, the instructor will talk to the students about clay and demonstrate the making of the tile.
5. Initial instructions are then given for the students to work at their desks on their hand-built projects, additional instructions being given as necessary.
6. Once the hand built project is complete; we will distribute several small containers of various colours of slip glaze. The students will receive the colours and brushes and proceed to paint their project. All work is gathered by Clay for Kids instructor to be returned to the studio to be fired, dipped in clear glaze and refired to a hard shiny finish.
7. Adult helpers are required for kindergarten, 1 for each 5 children. 1 or 2 adults are always welcomed for grades 1-3.
