FINISHING CLAY PROJECT

Please remind the children that clay pieces are very fragile and less handling is better. Use a glue gun for loosened decorations.

Preferred finish: For an additional \$6.00 the instructor will slip glaze your project directly after making it. The projects will be dried, fired, dipped in clear glaze and fired to a hard and shiny finish. The project comes back to you completely finished.

- 2) Projects can be finished **by** coating with **metallic paints** available from Clay for Kids and covered by spray on Clear Coat or water soluble paint on varnish.
- 3) Angel Plaques, Standing Angels, Nativity Scenes, Taj Mahal, Inukshuk should be covered in silver or gold glitter spray or metallic paints which is also from Clay for Kids and best to paint with water soluble varnish.
- 4) When painting a three dimensional projects always paint the base first.
- 5) For complex projects such as **Native Masks** and **Chinese Dragons**, we recommend that the students first sketch the project on paper. This enables them to select colours by using felt pens or pencil crayons before working on the final clay piece.

Glitter or clear sprays will not make the clay shiny without acrylic paint on the clay only the water soluble varnish will make the clay clay shiny. Wrap projects carefully in paper and our Clay for Kids plastic bags to ensure they arrive home safely. Thank you for supporting us and please let us know if you have any questions.
